**Charles River Center** – Bellingham, MA. Follow directions above for Whole Foods: they have Chili's, Regal Cinemas, Whole Foods, Old Navy, Gap, Footlocker and more.

**Stallbrook Marketplace** – Bellingham, MA. Follow directions above for Whole Foods: they have Barnes and Noble, McDonalds, WalMart, Staples and more.

Take that right – you are there. About 8 minute drive.

## RESTAURANTS

I have not visited all of these restaurants but have worked with reviews from locals. I hope this guide helps give some direction. Please give me feedback, positive or otherwise, so we can fine-tune this for future years – Dede Wilson

**Mango Thai Cuisine** – 9 Medway Rd. Milford, MA 01757 (508) 482-9779. Can handle larger crowds.

**Thai Pepper** – 178 East Main St. Milford, MA 01757 (508) 478-9022. Better for a smaller group. Has vegetarian menu. Duck and curries are specialties.

**Café Sorrento** – 143 Central St. Milford, MA 01757 (508) 473-2460. Good pizza, antipasto, and other Italian standards.

**Oliva's Market/Kitchen** – 83-85 East Main St Milford, MA 01757 (508) 473-7920. Sandwiches, salads and famous grinders (hoagies and subs for those from out-of-town) as well as wraps, panini and pasta. This is a great deli BUT the hot sandwiches are only available M-F from 9:30am to 2:30pm. The deli itself is open on the weekends for typical deli fare.

**Prezzo Grille** – 229 ½ East Main St. (Rt. 16) Milford, MA 01757 (508) 634-0101 Somewhat Italian inspired food. Calamari, Pasta, lots of soups and salads, half-portions available, chicken, seafood and meat entrees, thin-crust pizza too.

**The Alamo** - 55 Medway Rd. Milford, MA (508) 482-0300 – Tex-Mex food. Owned by the father of Malcom-in-the-Middle star Erik Per Sullivan, who has been known to wait on tables☺. Go for the margaritas and karaoke.

**Acapulco's** – 231 East Main St. Milford, MA 01757 (508) 478-7197. Mexican mom and pop. Several locations loved by locals. Nachos, fajitas, burritos, enchiladas and more and good vegetarian options, too. Virgin and “full strength” margaritas as well as several tequilas on hand.

**Hang Thai** - 26 West Central Street #30, Franklin, MA 02038 (508) 520-8828. This is Chinese food folks, not Thai - Typical Chinese menu, but apparently well done.

**Truffles Grille and Wine Bar** – 198 East Main St. Milford, MA 01757 (508) 482-1700. Fine Dining. Extensive, award-winning wine list. Seafood, lamb, risotto, and signature Bistro Burger and Five Peppercorn Steak.

**Lin's Garden** – 206 East Main St. Milford, MA 01757 (508) 966 – 0588. Chinese food.

**Alicante Mediterranean Grille** - 84 Uxbridge Rd. (Rt 16) Mendon, MA 01756 – (508) 634-8188. Calamari, stuffed clams, mussels, salads, pasta, other seafood, chicken and meats.

**Casa Brazil** – 112 Main St. Milford, MA 01757. Brazilian food featuring Lots of Meat!

**Ma Glockner's** – 151 Maple St. Bellingham, MA (508) 966-1085. Opened Thanksgiving Day 1937. The Original Home of Berched Chicken Dinners. What does this mean? Half-chickens are par-cooked in a seasoned broth then finished to order on a grill and always served with cinnamon buns. Moist inside and crispy on the outside. Salad, soup, steak, burgers too as well as some seafood and pasta, but go for the chicken. New England Grapenut Pudding, also served.

**Spruce Pond Creamery** – 370 King St. Franklin, MA 02038 (508) 520-7900. Organic wood-brick oven pizza and ice cream. Great vegetarian options. Considered a gem in a small town. A dairy makes cream to their specifications and it is all made in small batches. Try the Black Strawberry with black raspberries, strawberries and flecks of chocolate or the Honey Graham with a caramel base and graham crackers. The Baci, which is hazelnut with Frangelico liqueur and milk, white and dark chocolate chunks ain't shabby either....or the Peanut Butter Cookie Explosion...or the Black Forest...Raspberry Chocolate Truffle, etc.

**Union Street Café** – 371 Union St. Franklin, MA 02038 (508) 528-4961. Old school Italian. Carryout available. Make reservations for larger groups. Serves lunch and dinner.

**The Rome Restaurant** – 4 East central St. Franklin, MA 02038 (508) 528-4740. Affordable Italian; a local institution.

**Nicky's** – 460 Franklin St Wrentham, MA 02093 (508) 384-8283. Friendly ambiance, diner-esque style, all reasonably priced. Cheeseburger clubs and Coffee Milk Shakes, Clam strips and clam chowder.

## Driving Directions

**Hotel to Show Site:** Take right out of parking lot toward Medway Street. Left at light, which is Medway Street (Rt. 109). Take ramp for I-495 South toward Cape Cod for 10.7 miles. Take Exit #15/Wrentham/Plainville toward Wrentham/Norfolk. Take a left onto South St. (Rt. 1A) and follow road (it curves sharply to right at one point) for about 2.2 miles. You will pass through the center of Wrentham. Pass through the intersection of Rt. 140. Take a left at blinking yellow light, which is North St. Look for Emerald St. on left and Dog Show signs. Total driving time is 20 minutes or less.

**Hotel to Tennessee BBQ:** Take left out of parking lot to lights. Take left at lights onto East Main St. (Rt. 16). Restaurant is down on the left. Total driving time is less than 5 minutes.
