For those who haven't gotten to know me over the years, I have been a member of the BTCA since 1971 with a small break while establishing my veterinary practice in the early 80's. I have served the Club in many ways during that time, from committee memberships or chair person on up. I have served on the Board of Directors as a Member at Large, then Second Vice-President, First Vice-President, and 2 terms as President of our Club. Following my Presidency, I became the Judges Education Chair, developed the currently used seminar and was able to promote our breed and train aspiring judges for 7 years. During my terms as President, I led the Board in establishing the genetic disease testing program, the Health Committee, and worked directly with the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals to establish the very first breed registry for genetic diseases, a program that now certifies all breeds as tested for many genetic diseases. I also established the regional Representatives program and the Futurity Competition. I struggled unsuccessfully to establish safeguards to protect the Club's treasury, which as we know now was an unfortunate oversight by the Board at that time. Besides breeding, I have judged our breed throughout the world over the years, enabling me to get a larger vision of Bull Terriers and their owners.



In the greater realm of the dog fancy, I have been showing dogs since 1968 starting with Doberman Pinschers, then Bull Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, and Miniature Bull Terriers. I have held club offices in multiple all-breed and group clubs. I have been an AKC licensed judge since 1997, with 7 breeds currently, and am working toward additional breed approvals in the Working, Terrier, and Herding groups.

On the business side, I am the owner of two veterinary hospitals here in Utah one of which is a canine reproduction center, and a partner in the international firm, Sires on Ice, Pty, specializing in the collection and transport of genetic materials for breeders. In this capacity I have attempted to help breeders from around the world reach their breeding goals.

I am running for AKC Delegate, to represent the BTCA and its membership at the AKC as rules and policies are formed. I will take my historical knowledge of the BTCA and my experience with AKC events and policies to the Delegate meetings as your spokesperson. If elected, I will always be eager for your input and try to represent everyone in the Club. After all, this is your Club and as your Delegate I will always function with that in mind.
