### **American Bred Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> **Madcap Jump Right In**, by Emred Devil's Spy ex GCH Madcap Jump the Broom, Breeders J & M. Lindquist, Owners: Keith & Gail Reber. Tricolor dog with some excellent breed virtues. Compact, short backed, well made, good reach of neck, very good substance, lovely bone, beautiful straight forelegs, long, powerful head, well filled, keen eye, strong underjaw, perfect bite, stands and moves a little base-wide in front, nice sidegait and good on the go. **Winners Dog, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex**

### **12-18 Months Bitches**

1<sup>st</sup> **Formula's Powerful Scarlets Wonder on Blue Ridge**, by Emred Devil's Advocate ex GCH Action Headed for Fame Power, Breeder: Krista Prater Piles, Owner: Jonathan Racey. Beautiful red/white bitch, gorgeous long swept over profile, good fill, instanding canine, beautiful bone, excellent substance, well let down hock, sound mover, very high quality, rather flat over the croup. **Reserve Winners Bitch**

2<sup>nd</sup> **Some Okie's Sky Walker**, by GCH Some Okie's Redneck Kracker ex Arnold's Legally Blond at Some Okies, Breeder: A Cox, Owner: Ivory Miceli. Tricolor, also a beautiful head profile, eye a little bigger than the bitch above her, incisors off, nicely put together and sound on the go but not showing too well today.

### **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> **Sandstone's Honky Tonk Angel**, by GCH Tulsadom Albi Albon ex Caen Making Muse-ic with Sandstone, Breeders/Owners: Melanie and Ty Whitehair. Red/white, powerful bitch, well made, excellent bone and substance, sound mover, deep, powerful head, good fill, good profile, eye correct shape but could be smaller, incisors off, carries her tail very proudly. **Winners Bitch**

### **Best of Variety**

**BV CH Sandstone's Moonlight Over The Maidens With Terjos**, by Megaville's Visions ex Ch Terjo's Touch of Magic, Breeders/Owners: Melanie and Ty Whitehair. Super typey, well put together, excellent substance, lovely bone, beautiful front, powerful, filled and extra wide head, slight incisor fault.

**SB CH Madcap Jump Over the Moon**, by Emred Devil's Spy ex GCH Madcap Jump the Broom Breeders/Owners: J & M. Lindquist. Beautiful long head, bite off, well put together, competing strongly for the variety today.

## Whites

### **12-18 Month Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> **Optimus Prime BT Enamorada**, by Quentinhill Megatron ex Aricon Eyesadora, Breeder: Lizbieta Ternowska-Wyrwa, Owner: Erin Betancourt. Red head mark, well made dog, good bone and substance, stands well in front, strong head but lacks a little bit in profile with slight brow, bite good, moved OK. **Reserve Winners Dog**

### **Bred By Exhibitor**

1<sup>st</sup> **Sorabully's It's About Time**, by GCH Allegro Rockstar ex Sorabully's Iron Empress, Breeder/Owner: Heidi Clayton. Interesting young dog, outstanding length and width of head, decent profile, incisors off, very shapely and athletic, carries his tail proudly. **Winners Dog, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex**

### **6-9 Months Puppy Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> **Bullhill BW Troubles First Flight**, by Magor Born to Fly ex Bullyhill Kaleco Flirtn With Trouble, Breeder: Teena Troy, Owners: Kathy & John Russo. This is a very well grown bitch for her age, bone, substance, nicely made, pleasing profile, bite tight in all regards, a little soft on the go and a little soft in topline but I expect much to tighten up as she matures.

### **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> **Madcap Jump for Joy**, by Emred Devil's Spy ex GCH Madcap Jump the Broom Breeders: J & M. Lindquist, Owners: Annie Glaser & J & M Lindquist. This is a gorgeous bitch, beautifully put together, gorgeous head in all ways with length curving profile, depth, underjaw, fill, eye could be a bit smaller and bite is rather problematic, excellent bone and substance, moved well enough. Super, super type. **Winners Bitch**

### **American Bred Bitches**

1<sup>st</sup> **Bully Moon's Solitaire with Sandstone**, by Megavilles Sardonicus ex GCH Sandstone's Visions of Liberty, Breeders/Owners: Terry & Ellen Blum. Very showy, upstanding bitch with nice neck, good head profile, good fill, bite off, OK in front but not great feet, strong rear, fluid mover. **Reserve Winners Bitch**

2<sup>nd</sup> **Old England's Barefoot Contessa at Adobe**, by Teirwgywn Paper Gansta At Bullyview ex GCH Old England's White Imperial Empress, Breeder: M & S McConnell, Owner: Steven & Shelly Block. Another really pretty bitch, I loved the make and shape of this girl, again a lovely headpiece with lovely fill, bite wrong, didn't move as well as the winner and unfortunately she did not show too well.

### **Open Bitches**

1<sup>st</sup> **Creekside No Doubt**, by GCH Winsor and Legacy Red Hot Habanero ex Emred Devil Wears Black, Breeder: D. D'Aquila, Owner: Scott Wylie. I liked this bitch quite well, very powerful head with perfect bite, stood well in front, good mover, good bone, slack in her shoulder and would have liked her in tighter condition which may well have brought her higher awards.

2<sup>nd</sup> **Teirwgywn Moonlight**, by Teirwgywn Latest Flame ex Teirwgywn Secret Potion, Breeders: A. & N. Roberts, Owners: Tadas Ratkevicius. Powerful and immaculately put together bitch, substance and bone, good front, beautiful feet, compared to the winner her head is not quite as exceptional lacking a little in depth and underjaw to the winner but pleasing in turn

### **Best of Variety**

BV **GCHB Billianbully Belligerant At Bobuddy**, by BoBuddy Trifalger ex Seasons In The Sun At Billianbully, Breeder: Ian Reed, Owner: Connie Whitmer. One I've had before and she still stuns me with her exquisite beauty. She fits together with such flowing lines and class and perfection of symmetry that she is definitely the Elizabeth Taylor of Bull Terriers. Her head is gorgeously turned with little eyes, bite suffers a few slightly off incisors. Gorgeous silhouette and curves, I would wish for a little more bone. She is definitely a joy to see in the ring.
