Reserve Winners Dog

Alexander's **BRIGADOON BLACK WATCH JOCK O'BULLSEYE** (Ch. Cool Conquistador at Crossgarley ex Ch. Brigadoon La Belle Grande Dame): Tricolor with nicely turned head and keen expression – ears right up on top; incisors reversed; excellent bone plus tight cat feet; would like a longer upper arm; short back and muscular hindquarters; super showman; moved pretty well, especially going away.

Winners Dog, Best of Winners

Harlamoff & Wayne's **SOQUEL MILLENIUM SEAFARER** (Ch Rhydaman Frosty x Ch Soquel Millenium Black Fern): Exciting, rich brindle youngster; terrific head & varminty expression; bite correct, canines just a little tight; outstanding bone; still just a baby & so movement rather puppyish; happy, outgoing personality; has all the makings of a big winner.

Reserve Winners Bitch

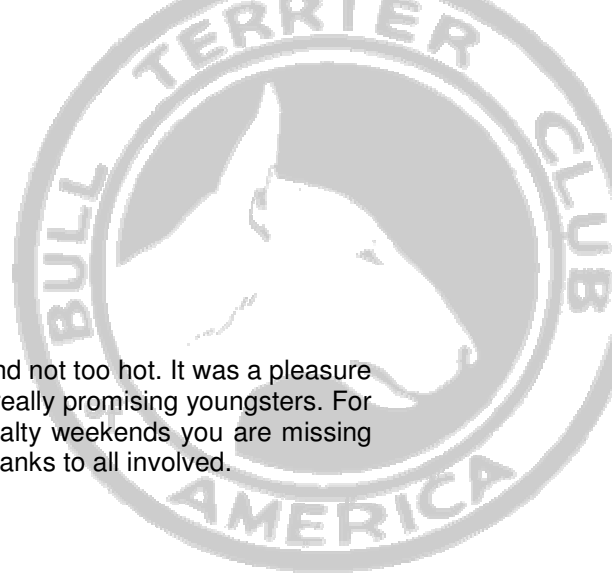
Alexander & Salvador's **BRIGADOON BANANARAMA OHANA** (Ch Kilacabar Cuchulainn x Ch Brigadoon Arriere Bannwalkin Tall): Elegant tiger-striped brindle pup; lovely feminine head with correct bite & well placed ears; excels in construction with well laid shoulders, short back & shapely hindquarters; would have garnered the movement prize if there had been one today; ideally I would like see stronger bone; beautifully presented.

Winners Bitch

Walthall and Woodruff's **EDELWIN'S HEART OF GOLD** (Ch Allegro Red Bull ex Ch Edelwin's Hugs But Not Kisses): Brindle with super bone & substance for her size; minimal white on her muzzle so it needs to be handled to appreciate its strength; good Roman finish; bite correct except for one misdirected incisor; excellent spring of rib & well muscled hindquarters; a tad long in loin; moved with ample reach & drive.

Best of Variety

Smith, Harlamoff & Wayne's **CH SOQUEL MILLENIUM THE BUCCANEER** (Ch Brummagem Spectacular Bid x Ch Brigadoon All Black Soquel): Black brindle in excellent form – I don't have anything to add to my last report on this dog *"tip top condition; good length and strength of head, well finished; typical expression; his cross is a reverse scissors bite; good reach of neck; super bone with ramrod straight front legs finishing in tight cat feet; shortest of backs; powerful, shapely hindquarters; moved beautifully."*



Best of Opposite Sex

DeVore's **CH KARISMAS FER GALICIOUS** (Ch Action Head Games ex Sunny Sky Everything Nice): Lovely brindle bitch with a dramatically turned & finished head; good front plus cat feet; well sprung ribs; excellent rear angulation with super short hocks; moved really well coming, a little closely going away; showed well.

Select Dog

Bebb, Hegg and Myall's **CH ICENI SHOT TAKEN** (Quicksilver Monster Truck ex Ch Icen Point Taken): Substantial brindle with top class head; ample bone and substance; powerful hindquarters which he used to good effect; against the BOV is rather long in loin; very well presented.

Select Bitch

Moran & Perrot's **CH APPRENTICE CUTNRUN OF SUNDANCE** (Apprentice's Runnin Around x Action Cajun Cutup): Older brindle bitch, with a very strong head & shapely body; scores well on overall breed type.

McCall and Baldrassin's **SILMARIL STRAIT UP SCHATZI FUNKADELIC** (Silmaril Saboteur ex Silmaril Samba): Strong well-filled head with good Roman finish; could have a better profile; correct bite; decent bone & substance; rather straight in stifle, which impacts his rear movement; well presented.

Utt's **ARDRY N BULLARDS SMOKE'N** (Ardry Desert Heat x Bullards Patrisha Amelia): Sorry overwrote my notes; promising youngster from the 9-12 puppy class.

Reserve Winners Bitch

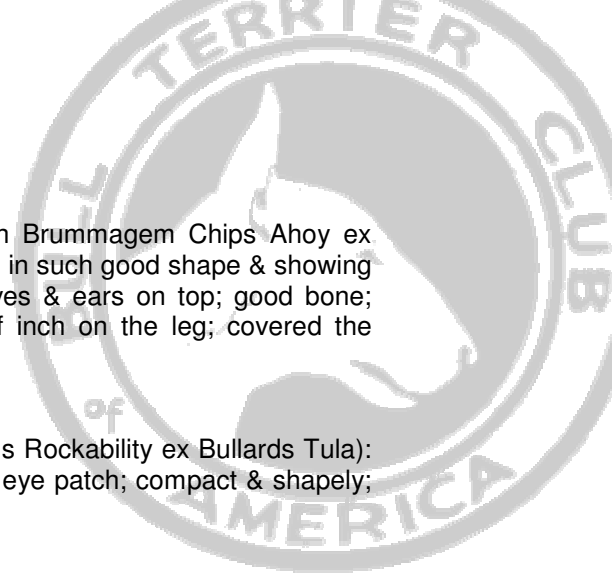
Hess & Bebb's **SUNNY SKY'S BELLATRIX DREAM** (Emred Huntsman x Sunny Sky Dream B'Right): Another typy youngster, smaller & less mature than winner; nicely turned & finished head with fawn ear/eye patches; correct bite; good topline; well let down behind; moved freely both ways; showed well.

Winners Bitch, Best of winners, Best of Opposite Sex

Niehouse, Belstock and Frascone's **SINABAR AND LOVE LIKE CRAZY** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic ex Sinabar La Vita E Bella): Typy youngster with a top class head & expression; superbly filled muzzle; wicked expression; straight front with quality bone plus tidy feet; ample spring of rib; good topline & tailset; a tad long in loin; moved & showed enthusiastically with good drive going away.

Best of Variety

Harris' **ALLEGRO ROCKSTAR** (Ch Allegro Red Bull x Ch Allegro Sticky Fingers): I had the pleasure of awarding this outstanding dog BOV as a pup last year & he is certainly maturing apace; this broth of boy captures one's attention as soon as enters the ring; head absolutely packed & superbly turned; plus a wicked expression & correct bite; super bone & substance; could be a little cleaner in shoulder; excellent spring of rib; good tailset; powerful hindquarters; moved enthusiastically, exuding Bully energy.



Select Dog

Belstock's **CH BELBAR'S MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM** (Ch Brummagem Chips Ahoy ex Belbar Sinabar White Merlot): What a pleasure to see this veteran in such good shape & showing beautifully; excellent type all around; head filled with darkest eyes & ears on top; good bone; shapely body & hindquarters; ideally should have an extra half inch on the leg; covered the ground really well.

Select Bitch

Gothan & Wong's **CH BULLARDS NOLA SUNSHINE** (Ch Moxie's Rockability ex Bullards Tula): More terrier-type bitch with a very nice head, replete with brindled eye patch; compact & shapely; moved and showed well.
