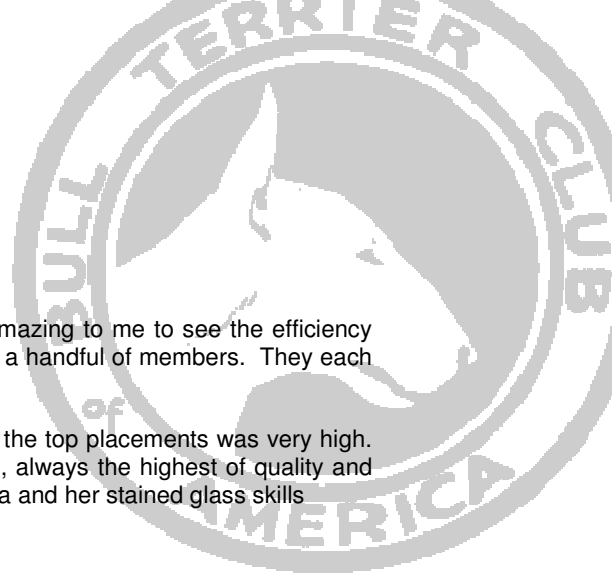


Bull Terrier Club of St. Louis

Winners Dog and Best of Opposite Sex

Poole and Stafford's **ROCKY TOP'S OUTLAW KID** (CH Rocky Top's Sundance Kid ex Barrseas J'Aime a Vie) There is no mistaking "who's your daddy" when you stand in front of this young dog and see the expression of daddy Rufus looking back at you, This is a very promising young dog, far from maturity but exhibiting a lot of class. He is deep rich red in color and shapely with nice leg under him, His head is well turned and he has good finish. Viewed from the front his head is long with wicked expression set off by smut markings. His mouth is a reverse scissors with correct canines. He stands foresquare from the front and has good forechest for his stage of development. Nice bone for size. He has good reach of neck and smooth topline that holds up on the move. I would prefer more second thigh and muscular development in the rear and more drive on the move, Overall, he is quite a handsome boy and I was pleased to award him Winners dog and Best Opposite Sex and look forward to see him as he matures.

There was a very large class of variety colored males, but this guy just screamed class, and in spite of his young age of 13 months, I decided to go all the way with him.

Reserve Winners Dog

Schuur and Petersen's **OLD FORGE THE SPENDID SLPINTER** (Ch Sarajeni Rockn AtPhilgin ex Modern Velvet Touch at Old Forge) Super brindle and white heavyweight with oodles of virtues including a massive, filled head with gentle profile, and loads of round bone down to tight feet. A perfect bite He has a beautifully let down forechest and straight front legs, a nice layback of shoulder, decent topline, and well muscled rear. Unfortunately, after repeated attempts on the move, his pacing continued and I had to award him second place. It was his second day in the ring.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best of Variety

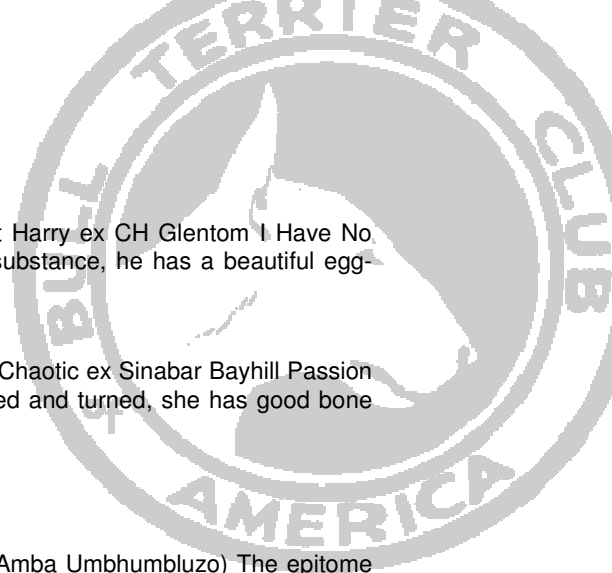
Smith's **MAGOR MILLENIUM MOONSTRUCK** (CH Rhydaman Frosty ex CH Magor Millenium Mardi Gras) From the moment she set foot in the ring, it was "who's going to be second?" for me. This is a very typey, nicely marked, rich brindle and white with a gorgeous headpiece, fully filled and packed up to the end, mouth is scissors. Eye is well placed and dark, would prefer better placed ears, She is shapely throughout and has lots of substance with a broad forechest and beautiful straight front. What I like best about her is the view from the side as she poses herself perfectly each time she stands. She has a well-let-down rear and plenty of muscling in the second thigh, topline is correct. Fully mature for her young age, she is one of the ones I would love to take home.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Frascone's **SINABAR AFFAIR TO REMEMBER** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic ex Sinabar Triple Trouble) Dark brindle and white, more upstanding than my winner, with lots of extreme virtue, a gorgeous headpiece also, mouth reverse scissors. She has beautiful bodylines and lots of substance, is well constructed and moving accordingly. She was unlucky to run into the winner of this class, a very deserving bitch who is most deserving of a ROM status.

Veteran Bitch

Wright's **CH GLENTOM MINT JULEP** (CH Stellar Southern Cross ex CH Glentom Doublemint O'Berkshire) This lovely brindle lady was in tip top condition for ten years old and clearly enjoyed her moment in the limelight. Lovely headed.



Select Dog

Cournoyeur's **CH GLENTOM DIRTY HARRY** (Marshelsea How's About Harry ex CH Glentom I Have No Commint) Cobby red and white of average size, with lots of type and substance, he has a beautiful egg-shaped head and correct bite. He is short backed and moved well.

Select Bitch

Frascone's **CH SINABAR PASSION FOR FASHION** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic ex Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) Well-dressed brindle and white with a lovely headpiece, fully filled and turned, she has good bone and moved well in both directions.

WHITE

Winners Dog, Best of Winners and Best of Variety

Hopkins' **TULSADOOM ABI ALBON** (Emred Huntsman ex Tulsadoom Amba Umbhumbluzo) The epitome of a heavyweight stud dog in full maturity We do not see dogs with this power often, in the USA. I have watched this dog since he was a puppy. Finally at full maturity, he is indeed impressive, well muscled in a shining white coat, He has a blocky strong headpiece with captivating, deeply-set eye with oodles of expression. Ears could be smaller. He has a strong, arched neck, flowing smoothly into his strong topline. Back is a little long for my liking, but he carries himself with assurance and power. From the front, he has heavy round bone, and moves parallel towards with elbows tightly in and a little softening in the pasterns, He strode out well from behind.

Winners Bitch

Whitmer and Thomas' **BRETAND BIG EASY** (Lamellar Hinderton Lad ex Brigadoon Luck Bee a Lady) Feminine, medium-sized white with brindle ears who is a quality bitch. She has a smoothly turned head with a correct bite. From the front, she could have a more wicked eye, but it is well-placed high up on her head. She has a nice layback of shoulder and straight front. Her back is bit long with a hump that is notable on the go around, but not when standing. She is impeccably presented and in gleaming white, nicely-muscled condition.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Schneider and Wright's **GLENTOM LEBOEUF QUEEN DANCING CREEK** (CH Dazlin Defiance ex CH Glentom Pearljam DeMint) White with fully turned and filled headpiece.

Best of Opposite Sex

Croucher's **GLENTOM ACIE'S NOT A THING TO WEAR** (CH Victoria's Grimaldi Windfall ex CH Acie's Glentom Dress for Success) Beautifully-headed white with perhaps the best expression of the day. She has a deep forechest and straight front, her topline today was slack and her rear, which does have a good second thigh, was not muscled well enough. She did move well in both directions, her owner has had surgery, so unfortunately this bitch was not in the condition of last fall when she was awarded the Silverwood trophy. This cost her at the end today,

Select Dog

Anderson and Corse's **GCH CORSAIRE THE COURIER** (CH Sarajeni Rockn atPhilgin ex Corsaire Dancing Cloud) A typey, medium-sized white dog in perfect weight and coat today. He has a block of a head, well turned and filled, with a wicked eye, a strong and clean neck, and straight front. When viewed from the front, he s a little low on leg, giving him a longish appearance, but he has a strong topline which he maintains on the go around. He tracks in coming towards and moves away well with a good second thigh. Great virtue to offer.

Select Bitch

Corse and Allen's **OC CORSAIRE WITCH OF THE WAVES OF MALVERN** (GCH Corsaire the Courier ex CH OC Harbour Lights O'Malvern) Very virtuous 10-month-old puppy, already a champion, she exudes type, she has a dramatically-turned head with a wicked eye, and a correct bite. She is bullish in front coming towards and moves well going away.
