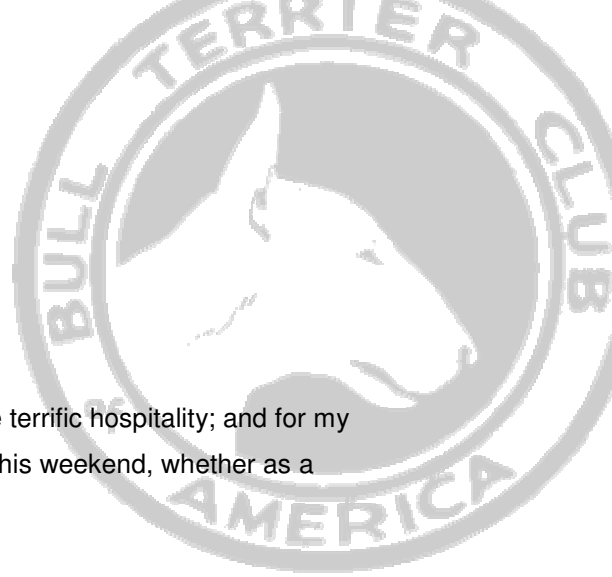

Winners Dog & Best of Opposite Sex

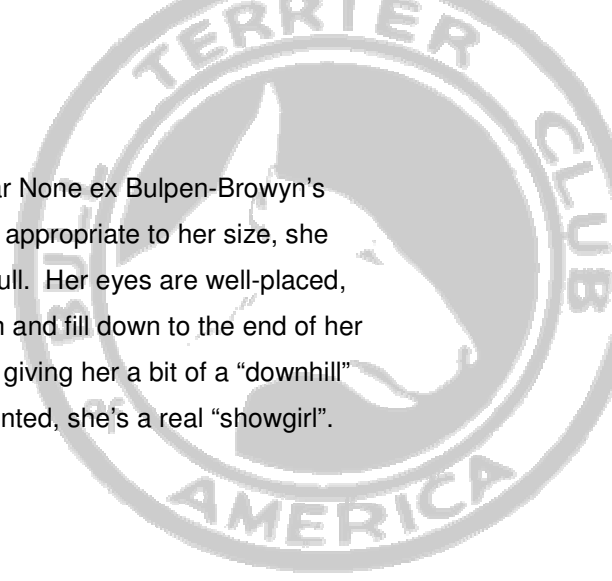
Bader, Plano, Cairns & Wendler's **SHAZAM ST GEORGE BIG STING** (Ch Gwynsel It's Not Unusual ex Ch Shazam's Bit O'Honey) Attractive egg of a head on this square and typey brindle boy, marred by an unfortunate mouth fault. He has very nice expression head-on, with neat little ears right on top of his head and well placed, dark eyes. A moderate size, he has good round bone that is appropriate to his style and substance, coming right down to his feet. His movement is jaunty and clean, all ways of the ring. To be critical, I'd prefer a bit more power in the muzzle and more shoulder layback, but he's an attractive package, and WD for his breed type, and virtue.

Reserve Winners Dog

Uplinger's **ANNWN ENUFF SAID** (Activior Euff Already At Kilacabar ex CH Mayhem Hot To Trot) Tri color puppy, still very immature, but with a really dramatic head, long and turned, with bite off. His ear set is a bit low, dark eyes are well placed and shaped. Bone is appropriate to his moderate size and current development. Looking at the catalogue, I see he was entered in the 6-9 month class yesterday, and the 9-12 class today. He is cheerful and outgoing, moves happily, but a bit close behind. At this point, he is a bit long cast, and tends to carry a high topline and tail set. RWD on his head quality and overall balance.

Winners Bitch/Best of Winners/Best of Variety & Best Puppy

Hennessy & Brodeur's **WENDIGO BREAKING BAD** (Ch Philgin Goodfella ex Ch Wendigo Buoy Northern Exposure) What a stunning and mature puppy bitch. Pretty profile in her long, head, mouth a fingernail off with correct canines, neat ears on top of her head and well placed and shaped dark eyes. I would prefer a bit more width from the eyes down to the muzzle. She has lovely round bone, is of moderate size, and well balanced in her front and rear angulation. She moves cleanly all ways of the ring, with really good drive behind, holding her topline all the way around. At this point, she is looking a bit longer over the loin than ideal, but her type and overall balance and breed virtue carried her all the way to the top.



Select Bitch

Parrys' **GCH BULPEN'S DEVIL IN THE DETAILS** (Ann-Dee's Bar None ex Bulpen-Browyn's Boo's Legacy) A pretty tricolor bitch, with moderate size with bone appropriate to her size, she has a nicely turned head, with neat little ears right on top of her skull. Her eyes are well-placed, mouth is level with lower canines broken. I'd like to see more width and fill down to the end of her muzzle. She is very muscular and developed in the rear quarters, giving her a bit of a "downhill" silhouette. She moves neatly all ways of the ring. Beautifully presented, she's a real "showgirl".

WHITE

Winners Dog/Best of Opposite Sex

Clayton's **SORABULLY'S I AM GANG JO** (Ch Sarajeni's Rockn' At Philgin ex Ch Rockytop's Starlit Sky) A strapping big boy with a black ear, pleasant head with nice width and fill, gentle turn, and good muzzle strength. Little dark eyes are well placed and shaped; better ear placement would improve expression. His bite is good with one canine in-standing. Beautiful round bone leads down a clean front to nice feet, shoulder angle needs more layback, which would visually lengthen the neck. The topline is strong both standing and on the move, well angulated hindquarters provide nice drive behind. WD on his overall quality and balance.

Reserve Winners Dog

Wilson's **BELLATORS WARRIOR PRINCE** (Lubjan Monchou of Rizen ex Dajamani Velnico of Bellators) This is an eye-catching "egg" of a head, on an extreme Bull-type puppy. Incisors are correct with one canine inside the gumline; lovely little ears right on top of his head, with beautifully "varminty" eyes. His angulation is balanced front to rear, but his excess conditioning spoils the lines of his neck and shoulders. Cheerful and outgoing, his movement was quite competent when he settled. Bone is adequate, and his coat was truly beautiful and gleaming.

Winners Bitch & Best of Winners

Bass' and Nadeaus' **MAINELY'S BEWITCHED AND BEGUILLED** (Ch Gothic's The Kingmaker ex Ch Corsaire Sparkling Chrome) Well developed, substantial bitch, carrying brindle, this girl has a lovely profile, with neat ears on top of her head and evil little eyes. She could benefit from more width and strength from the eyes down to the muzzle. Her bone is proportionate to her size; fairly clean neck and shoulders lead to a strong topline and very well bent quarters. She moves cleanly all ways of the ring. WB on her substance, and balance.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Martin & Martin's **LONESTAR BONTERRA AT BULPIN BODINA** (Ch Rhydaman Frosty ex Khlolander Kinda Kool) A smaller bitch than the WB, this pretty girl is square and nicely balanced, with good angles front and rear. Her head is more moderate in profile, with proportionate width and fill. Neat ears are well placed on top of her head; eyes are well placed. Bite is ok, with both canines tight to the gums. Her movement is neat and precise all ways of the ring. I would prefer more bone and substance.

Best of Variety

Idone & Berez's **GCH CH ACTION CHAOS I'M SO DELICIOUS** (Ch Brummagen Chips Ahoy ex Ch Action Chaos and Charisma) A stylish Terrier type bitch, with a long strong head, and bite just off. Neat ears are right on top of her head, eyes are well placed but could be more keen. Elegant neck leads to short back; more angulation would improve her movement. She's a tidy, balanced package, beautifully presented.
