1st WALKIN TALL TRIUMPH O'BRIGADOON. By Ch Seawind Citadel O'Brigadoon - Ch Brigadoon Fire Bird. Owner: Dan Olage & Teresa Robertson & Dan Lowden, Breeder: D & C Alexander & T Robertson & D Lowden. Red/white handsome boy with good bone, good substance, very powerful head with width and fill, pleasing profile, good bite. Could be keener in eye and would like more powerful rear movement.

2nd BRIGADOON BLACKWATCH JOCK O'BULLSEYE. By Ch Cool Conquistador At Gressgarley - Ch Brigadoon La Belle Grande Dame. Owner: D & C Alexander, Breeder: C & D Alexander & M & N May. Tricolor dog with beautiful outline – very short backed, good angles, nice bone. Head long and nicely filled with keen eye, less powerful in muzzle than above and incisors under. He went well but came a little wide. He didn't have quite enough ribspring for me at this point but some wonderfully strong virtues.

1st BULLARDS HODGES OF ARDRY. By Ch Ardry Desert Heat - Ch Jael's Hammer Of Bullards. Owner: Philip McNiel & Jan Gothan, Breeder: Ted & Jan Gothan. Splash marked brindle/white – more of a Dalmatian type, long head, good scissors bite, pleasing profile. Overall nicely made, would like rounder bone, moved adequately going and came back nicely.

1st SARAJENI EASY RIDER. By Rodeo Rider The Joker - Sarajeni Calamity Jane. Owner: Jan Dykema & Franne Berez, Breeder: Norm Jessup. Reddish almost wheaten brindle/white – this is a truly top class dog. Superb bone running down to good feet, gunbarrel front; long, wide, deep and powerful head with good mouth, nice eye. Loved his neck into shoulder; nicely turned rear; good body shape and proportions. Went OK, came nicely, nice sidegait. **WINNERS DOG and AWARD OF MERIT.** He pressed hard for BOSV but lost his concentration toward the end.

2nd BESTUVALL ZINFANDEL MOON. By Ch Crestmonts Savoir Faire - Ch Bestuvall Copy Writer. Owner: Gary Tesconi, Windsor, Breeder: Gary Tesconi & Jan Dykema. Dark brindle/white. Another good sized dog with lovely bone and substance. Lovely head from the front with really keen eye, under incisors and misplaced canines, good profile. Didn't stand quite so true in the front as the dog above him. Would like more turn to the stifle. Came better than he goes, covered the ground well from the side. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG**

Outstanding head with length, profile long and smoothly curving with nice finish, loved the fill and tiny eye, good bite. Lovely bone carried down to her well arched feet. Good substance. Would like a longer, more angulated forehead. Looking a little bit long cast just now. Came and went OK.

Attractive bitch who will be more impressive with maturity. Nice head, decent bone, decent body, nice feet, a little restricted in movement, adequate coming and going.

Lovely make and shape on this girl, beautiful shoulder angle and rear angle, fit and hard, correct substance. Stood beautifully in front with ramrod front, good feet. Powerful mover with wonderful rear drive, good coming and lovely from the side. To be critical she could have just a tad more bone. Red/White – upstanding and striking dog with stallion like qualities. Long head with good profile and lovely finish, nice fill, under incisors. Beautiful reach of neck; well made all through; good proportions; reasonable bone; would like him to stand truer in front; exceptional rear movement with power and drive and tracking beautifully.

SELD CH SOQUEL MILLENIUM SEAFARER. By Ch Rhydaman Frosty - Ch Soquel Millenium Black Fern. Owner: Gail Harlamoff & Naomi Waynee, Breeder: Gail Harlamoff & Naomi Waynee. Brindle/white – beautifully marked dog, good overall outline; lovely bone; head is very powerful with width, super fill down through his wide muzzle and lovely profile. Could be a bit straighter with his feet; not quite the structural qualities of the dog ahead of him; moved well coming and going. Surprised to know he's just over 9 months.

SELB CH BESTUVALL BARBERA MOON. By Ch Crestmonts Savoir Faire - Ch Bestuvall Copy Writer. Owner: Robert Cooley & Jan Dykema, Breeder: Gary Tesconi & Jan Dykema. Dark brindle/white – real quality in this bitch; well made through; good bone; very pretty head, good expression, under incisors. Loved the way she stood in front with gorgeous straight legs.

Very typey boy, I liked his outline in the go around with a very good topline with correct slight arch over the loin. Head is long and deep, lovely strength of muzzle, small eye, instanding canines. Lovely bone and substance; stood well in front with good straight forelegs; moved adequately. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG**

2nd ARDRY N BULLARDS SMOKE'N. By Ch Ardry Desert Heat - Bullards Patrisha Amelia. Owner: Kristy Utt DVM, Breeder: Jan & Ted Gothan. Nice dog with happy attitude; head of good length, would like more fill, nice eye; would like a little more bone.

Beautifully headed dog, good depth, length, profile and powerful, wide muzzle. Moved nicely. Good bone and substance. Would like better shoulder layback.

2nd BULLARDS SEVEN SEAS. By Ch Bullards Boaz - Ch Jaels Hammer Of Bullard. Owner: Ted & Jan Gothan, Breeder: Jan Gothan. Not quite as typey as above needing more fill and power in the head. That said this is a very well made dog with very good movement. Good triangular eye. Good bite. Could use a little more bone, good substance.

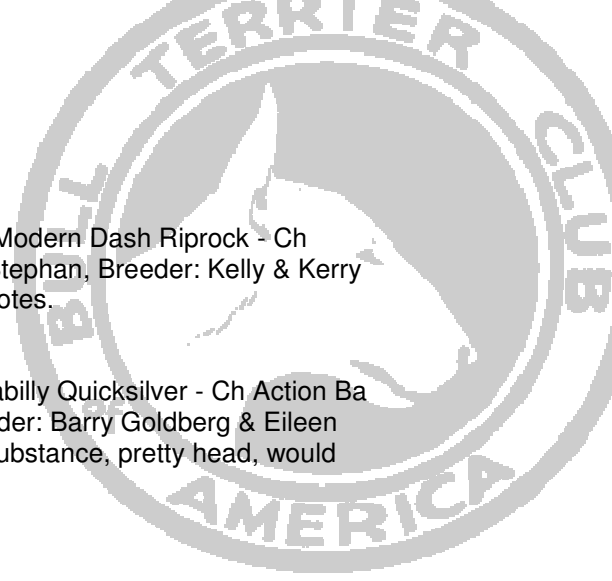

Head is deep with nice profile and length of foreface, small eye. Pretty, shapely body – I wish this were more evident in the breed overall as it's essential to correct bull terrier type. Moved well coming and going and has a huge open sidegait, easily covering maximum ground – that may not be specified in the standard but it is the proof of sound make and athleticism. **WINNERS DOG and BOSV**

Puppy, 6 & Under 9 Months Bitches.

1st JUMP 'N' JIVE AT BULLISTIC THE JOKER. By Ch Megavilles Vision - Ch Seventh Heaven The Joker. Owner: Irene & David Morden, Breeder: Cathie & Rudi Dettmar. Sweet baby girl just on 7 months with much growing to do. That said she has a houseful of promise. Her forehead is splendid with rarely seen good return of upper arm giving her a beautiful forechest and well tucked in forelegs which stood well in front. I would give her a bit shorter back but body shape is good. Moved well.

SELD GCH ALLEGRO ROCKSTAR. By Ch Allegro Red Bull - Ch Allegro Sticky Fingers. Owner: Duff & Susie Harris, Breeder: Duff & Susie Harris. Big nicely made powerful dog much in the same vein as my WD/BOS winner. Head is deep and well filled with small eye and good bite. He is a little skully in profile which cost him a higher placement. Good bone and substance.
