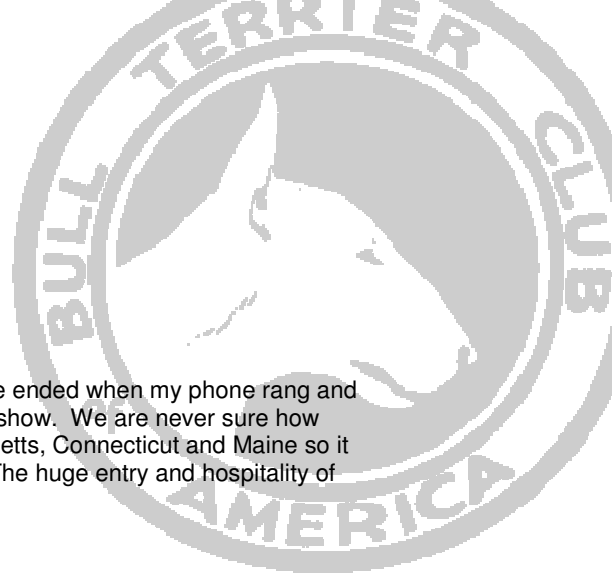


**Bull Terrier Club of New England

COLORED

Winners Dog

Symon and Bozian's **BULLAYR HEARTBREAKER** (Emred Huntsman x CH Scarlet Moon the Joker) A substantial brindle dog with excellent proportion. Presented in excellent condition he is a solid and square package. A superior headpiece with good eye placement. Width of head, muzzle and under jaw all above average. Ears are just a bit wide. When standing he presents a nice silhouette which he carries well as he moves. Very deep chest with a straight front, I would wish for a bit better shoulder as his is a bit upright but certainly better than most. Also would like to see a bit more rear angulation as his stifle is a bit straighter than ideal. Small matters though in what are a first rate dog with many desirable traits to pass along to his offspring.

Reserve Winners Dog

Shuur's **OLD FORGE GENTLEMAN JIM** (Sarajeni Rockn AtPhilgin x Modern Velvet Touch at Old Forge) A big husky red dog with an incredible amount of bone, large packed and filled head which pushed his ears a bit wide. He possesses quality eye placement with correct expression. His topline is a bit flat but front and rear angulation is good. His movement is reasonably smooth, though his body lines could use a bit of clean up.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Remer, Mackay-Smith and Lamkin's **BANBURY BEDROCK BRIGHT STAR BRIGHT** (Emred Huntsman x Banbury Bright Sky of Bedrock RN, NA, NAJ) A simply stunning medium-size brindle bitch. A beautiful profile with eye placement and muzzle length spot on. Tidy ears, which she always seems to use, on top of her head where they belong. When viewed from the side standing she is nearly ideal. The good news is that view does not change when she moves. Very jaunty and eager to please her handler. She moves with purpose. Excellent forechest and a straight front. One of the best shoulders on this day. I would wish for a better tailset which is a bit high and she is also a tad wide in the rear which her great conditioning more than compensated for. Pushed for BOV as hard as she could!

Reserve Winners Bitch

Whitehair's **TERJO'S TOUCH OF MAGIC** (Megavilles Sardonicus x Javarke Calico of Terjo's) A beautifully proportioned black brindle and white bitch. Wonderful filled head with terrific expression. A very square and solid girl with a slightly flat topline. Well-muscled and developed chest with her front feet out just a bit. Did not affect her movement which was one of the best of the day. Very little not to like and on most days would have been an easy winner.

Best of Variety

Bavol's **GCH CH OLD ENGLAND'S COCO CHANEL** (Tulsadoom Abi Albon ex CH Old England's Milady in Red) A large, stunning brindle and white bitch. All the bone and substance you could wish for but still ultra-feminine. A flawless profile with width and ideal muzzle length. A smooth topline with correct front and rear holding it in place. She moves beautifully in all directions and showed every moment I looked at her. Whether standing, moving or under examination today, she simply refused to loose.

Best of Opposite Sex

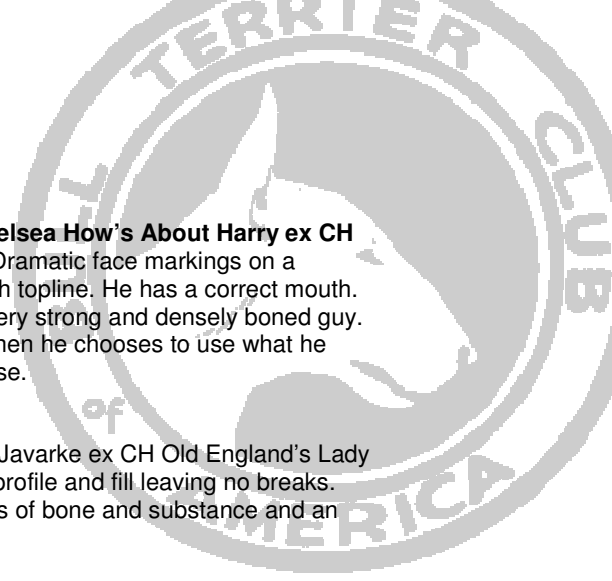
Thompson and Jasper's **GCH CH SKYLINE'S IN HOT PURSUIT (Marshelsea How's About Harry ex CH Skyline's Sticks N' Stones)** A very impressive red and white bull type. Dramatic face markings on a packed head. Excellent varnity expression. A well-set neck with a smooth topline. He has a correct mouth. He sets himself apart from the other heavyweights with a short back. A very strong and densely boned guy. Deep shape to his body with a well sprung rib cage. He is tremendous when he chooses to use what he has. A pleasure to watch and when he wanted to move it was with purpose.

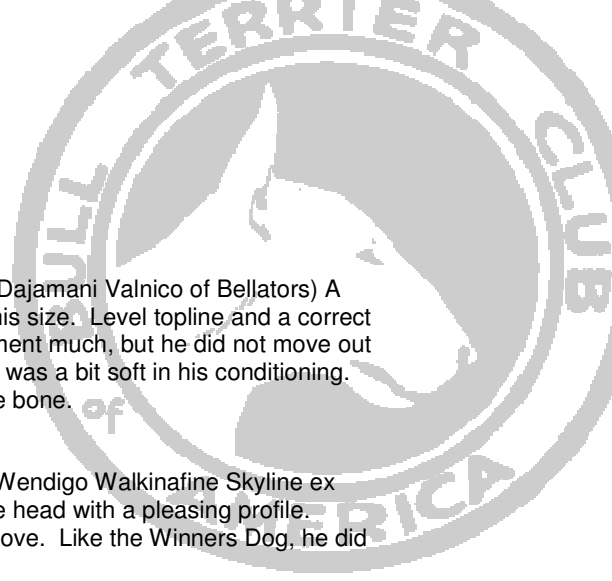
Select Dog

Bavol's **GCH CH Old England's Montgomery** (Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke ex CH Old England's Lady Elizabeth) A solid heavyweight red and white dog. A stunning head with profile and fill leaving no breaks. Eyes a bit larger than I would like. A completely square package with tons of bone and substance and an easy moving very happy dog.

Select Bitch

Pytko's **GCH CH BYRON'S PIECE OF MY HEART** (CH Bestuvall Razor Redi Cut ex Bryon's Queen of the Hop) Stunning black brindle and white bitch with a dramatic white face. She looks very lady-like and balanced. Wonderful profile and topline. She moves very smoothly. Well-handled and hard to miss with those distinctly feminine features most of us look for.





WHITE

Winners Dog

Wilson's **BELLATORS WARRIOR PRINCE** (Lubjan Monchu of Rhizen x Dajamani Valnico of Bellators) A big heavy dog with massive head and bone though a bit lethargic due to his size. Level topline and a correct front and rear when standing. A short upper leg did not restrict his movement much, but he did not move out with much reach. He is not fancy but very strong. An interesting dog that was a bit soft in his conditioning. In top shape he would be interesting to observe with his quality and dense bone.

Reserve Winners Dog

Jasper and Forrest's **SKYLINES JUST SINFUL AT BAYHILL** (CH Buoy Wendigo Walkinafine Skyline ex CH Skyline's Sweet Sin) A medium-sized dog with an earmark. Nice wide head with a pleasing profile. Ears a bit wide. Reasonable front with a slightly roached topline on the move. Like the Winners Dog, he did not show himself well today.

Best of Winners/Winners Bitch

Gilman and Whitehair's **CLASSIC ROCK JUST LIKE NU** (Ultimate Joy's Cool Casanova ex CH Sandstone's Classic Rock) A very feminine girl with ear marks. A near perfect outline when standing. Her head has a beautiful turn and more than sufficient fill. Excellent length of neck and a fabulous topline. She moved parallel and with drive coming and going. She couldm however, stand a bit more bone.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Allen's **OC LIGHTS ACTION FAME O'MALVERN** (CH Action Head Games ex CH OC Harbor Lights O' Malvern) A very stylish girl with a good head and expression. Lovely overall shape. Nice neck and front well blended together. Moved reasonably well, better coming than going. An attractive, beautifully presented promising young adult.

Best of Variety

Corse and Anderson's **GCH CH Corsaire the Courier** (CH Sarajeni Rockn AtPhilgin ex Corsaire Dancing Cloud) A well-known dog with a handsome headpiece. Well made with good angulation on both ends. A smooth neck into a better than average shoulder. Excellent bone and nice tight feet. Good topline and underline. An outstanding dog in reach, scope and type. He was shown in terrific condition and went on to a Terrier Group Three.

Best of Opposite Sex

McConnell and Baval's **GCH CH OLD ENGLAND'S WHITE IMPERIAL EMPRESS** (Tulsadoom Abi Albon ex CH Old England's Milady in Red) A lovely, sound bitch with black ear marks. Easy to admire with a well-filled head and smooth profile. She has a good front, nice neck and terrific topline. Carries herself well with corresponding depth; however I did not see as much of that as I would like because she did not show herself well at times today. She is a bit more masculine in body than I generally like. However, she had too many virtues to be ignored.

Select Dog

Wilson and Dussault's **CH LEGACY HUGHES YOUR DADDY OF WINSOR** (CH Victoria's Grimaldi Windfall ex CH Windsor's Hope Springs Eternal) Good-sized dog with a marked ear. Smooth filled and turned head. Terrific bone and substance. A stand-out dog that moves and shows with purpose.

Select Bitch

Corse, Allen and Anderson's **CH OC CORSAIRE WITH OF THE WAVES OF MALVERN** (GCH CH Corsaire The Corsair ex CH OC Harbor Lights O'Malvern) Typey, happy youngster with a bit of a pink nose, Just up from that is a wonderful head with a terrific profile right on the edge of too much. Plenty of width and fill. Short backed with correct topline on the move. It roaches a tad standing. Very showy and confident for a one year old.
