Best of Breed, B.O.V. Winners Bitch & B.O.W. #12

Remer, Lamkins & Mackay-Smith's BANBURY BEDROCK BRIGHT STAR BRIGHT. Referring to my critique notes I found that I had written just 2 words, simply stunning! This brindle bitch is etched on my mind and has it all. She has a beautiful head piece with power, depth & length, good underjaw & correct mouth, with a punishing expression. A long neck into clean lay of shoulder, correct front and feet. Good spring of rib, short back, well muscled, angulated rear quarters. She moved well with free easy strides and has drive from the rear. Also, to top of the package, she shows like a bomb for her handler and is the most beautiful shade of brindle. Without doubt, this bitch would take top honours anywhere in the world.

Decker & Berez's Ch. ACTIONS TURNING HEADS IN HOTLANTA. Well marked brindle, a strong head with a gentle profile. Has a wicked eye and expression with correct mouth. Good shoulders, front and catlike feet, moderate length in back, with good angulations to quarters. Moves well with purpose & drive. A little more spring of rib would complete the picture; nevertheless, he has type, quality & charisma in abundance, which demands attention.

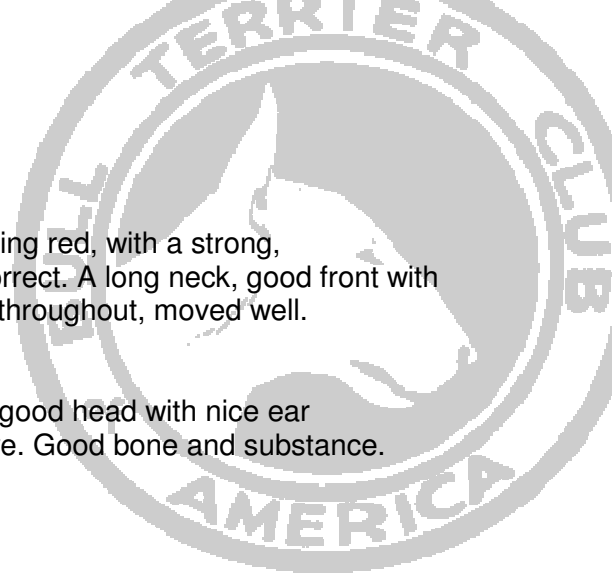
McLean & Baval's OLD ENGLAND'S DARKEST KNIGHT. Powerful Bl/br. Excellent strong head with fill & length, could use a touch more profile. Correct incisors, one tight canine. Clean neck into well laid shoulders, good front with nice round bone. Has a moderate length in back, moved well.

Reserve Winners Dog. #13

Parker & Cameron's NUANCE NIGHTCAP. Well balanced tri, excellent head, well filled with good profile, unfortunately his mouth is a reverse scissor. He has a very good lay of shoulder, good front and feet. Short back, well angulated rear quarters and moved well.

Reserve Winners Bitch. #16

Claburn's ACTION FIRST TRI. Beautiful, well balanced tri, shows with exuberance and animation. Lovely feminine head with correct mouth. Elegant reach of neck, good front and feet. Nice deep brisket, short back, has enough bone, sweeping bodylines throughout. Moved and handled well. A top class bitch in anyone's book; who was unlucky today to come up against Bright Star.



Select Dog. #37

Bavol's Ch. OLD ENGLAND'S MONTGOMERY. A tall upstanding red, with a strong, well filled head that could just use a touch more finish, mouth correct. A long neck, good front with nice round bone, moderate length in back, good make & shape throughout, moved well.

Select Bitch #40

Parry's GCh. BULPENS DEVIL IN THE DETAIL. Typy tri with a good head with nice ear placement. An average lay of shoulder which shows on the move. Good bone and substance.

B.O.V. Best of Winners. #48

Snyder, Hudson & Whitehair's SANDSTONES CONCEIVED IN LIBERTY FOR PARADOX. Well made, elegant bitch with a classic feminine head and stunning expression, mouth good. A long reach of neck, clean shoulder, good straight front and tidy feet. Maybe, I would like a little more bone all through. Nice length of back and shapely rear quarters. Never put a foot wrong, showed and moved covering the ground well.

Corse & Anderson's GCh. CORSAIRE THE COURIER. Well balanced with a very good strong, powerful head and correct mouth. Average shoulder, good front, well sprung rib and deep brisket. Good bone and substance, well muscled rear quarters, moved well when got into his stride. Just won over his son, who was winners dog, on maturity.

Winners Dog. # 51

Corse & Cederland's CORSAIRE DONALD MCKAY OF MALVERN. Well made with flowing lines throughout. Good head, filled with gentle profile, perfect mouth, wicked eye & correct ear placement giving punishing expression. A lovely reach of neck, good front and feet. Good rear angulations, though I would like more drive in rear movement. When he matures and bodies up he will take some beating.

Reserve Winners Dog # 57

Jaspers & Forrest's SKYLINE JUST SINFUL AT BAYHILL. Well made with a filled head and good profile; would like a touch more length in muzzle. Correct mouth and a stunning eye, abit reluctant to use his ears today. Good front, moderate length in back, moved & handled well.

Reserve Winners Bitch. #86

Parker & Rourke's NUANCE NONETHELESS. Typy with a good head and good mouth. Doesn't have the expression of the winners. Good power, bone and substance. Moved well.

Select Dog #59

Hopkins's Ch.TULSADOOM ABI ALBON. A masculine heavyweight with a strong, deep, powerful head and correct mouth. He has good, dense, round bone and he moves with drive & purpose. Today, I thought he was carrying too much weight which spoilt his lines.

Select Bitch #62

Wind & Berez's Ch. ACTION YANKEE QUEEN. Terrier type with enough head, a good bite and excellent expression. A decent length of neck, good front. Dips slightly at withers, which shows on the move. Showed & handled well.
