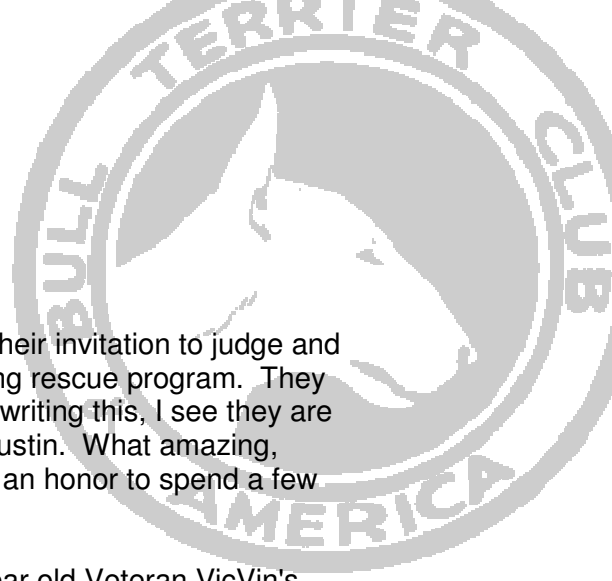


Texas Coast Bull Terrier Club


WHITE BULL TERRIERS

Winners Dog # 5 De Alba Ortiz & Jose De Jesus' **ROYAL LIONHEART DE ALBA**
By Angus Salazar -Lady Genova. Substantial, big boned male from the Open class. Quality head with some body deficiencies. A slightly bully front. Feet not tight. Sweet boy with good fill and correct bite.

Reserve Winners Dog #11 Joe Alvarez & Russell & Alesia Cooke's **LECHMERE'S SMOKING GUN**
By Super Bow'ls Iggypop-Ch Lechmere Glentom My Fair Lady. This young male won the Am Bred class over another quality male. He has overall correct make and shape with good topline and correct tail set. Very good forequarters construction and good forechest. Well balanced. Attractive head, that was not as not quite as strong or smooth in profile or as filled as WD.

Winners Bitch & BOW #28 Amber C Gibson's **NETHANBULL LIGHTNING BABE WITH CEILTEACH**
. By Camquest Eyecon-Scojan Wreaking Havoc. A very classy, compact young bitch with good bone and substance for size. I was surprised as I was writing this to note that she 4 years old. She was in very good condition and seemed quite perky/youthful. Lovely head and expression spoilt only slightly by a bit of a brow showing in profile. Typy. Overall good make and shape. Slightly down in pastern. Solid top line with correct tail set. Jaunty and upbeat on the move. Afterward, I was told this finished her CH.

Reserve Winners Bitch #12 Lionel A Landry & Pamela Landry's **DAUNTLESS MOJITA MISTRESS OF MAYHEM**
By Ch Emred Rum Runner-Ch Dauntless Izza Dazy Too. A very attractive, sound bitch, she won a competitive Am Bred class and Reserve because of her overall correct make and shape, pretty head and solid movement. Very good bone and substance. Lacks a little in expression, but overall good quality head. Does not seem to enjoy showing and sinks into herself. She has real potential, so making it fun and challenging for her in the ring may help her next time.



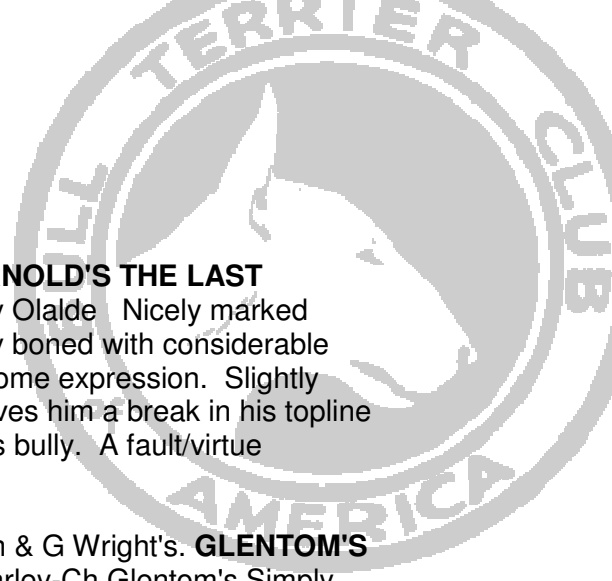
BOV #25 Jake & Heather Jones & Heike Knockaert's **CH YOECKYDOE'S GAMIN** By Alecto Kool Barracuda of Kilacabar-Laureola's Up To You. A smashing, eye catching male, who seems to own the ring. He shows with spirit and an exuberant kind of happiness that makes him impossible to overlook. His excellent head quality includes a handsome well turned profile, very good fill, well set ears and good dept of muzzle. Strong neck and solid forequarters. Good angles front and rear. Moves well, especially solid drive. He was pulled in group, but did not place in some very tough competition.

BOS #6 Carolyn & William Patterson & Glenna Wright's **CH GLENTOM RISING STAR** By Cool Conquistador At Grossgarley ex CH Glentom Silver Lining. Her beautiful smooth, filled head, good bone and substance helped her win over some top quality competition. Feminine, with lovely expression. A strong, well made bitch of good proportion. Although not showing with spirit, she moved adequately and has obvious first rate quality.

Select Dog #27 Annie Cox' **CH SOME OKIES KNIGHT OF D'BULL** By CH Noctural Knight At Arnolds ROM ex Blondi D'Rock And Bull. Powerful, well made male. Filled up head with typy expression, dark eyes, good depth of muzzle, and correct bite. Smooth profile without exaggerated downturn. Short backed with solid topline and good tailset. Not quite as balanced as BOV. Happy to see some good quality white males out competing.

Select Bitch #34 Glenna & Tom Wright's **CH GLENTOM STAR DREAMER** By Ch Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley-Ch Glentom Silver Lining. She has lovely head quality with a smoothly curved profile, keen eye, good depth and fill of muzzle. Strong underjaw, slightly under. Slightly long in back, she tends to stack herself rather poorly and seems high in rear. However, she is classy and moves well in both directions.

Best Puppy #22 Margaret & Sonny Saldivar's **ARNOLD'S PANDORA ROSE TO THE OCCASION**. By Ch Javarke King at Arnolds-Bullsunlimited Gaboon Viper. A lovely well proportioned youngster. Mouth fault. Moved well. Typy. Spirited, shows with controlled animation. Went on to a Puppy Gp 3 placement.

Winners Dog #17 Herssael Lopez & Arnoldo Salazar's **ARNOLD'S THE LAST DRAGON AT A.G.R.** . By CH Bull Sunlimited Arashi-Evoly Olalde Nicely marked brindle and white male from the Am Bred class, he is heavily boned with considerable substance. Powerful overall with a packed head and handsome expression. Slightly under. Long back and some lack of balance in angulation gives him a break in his topline on the move. Moves better in rear than on his front, which is bully. A fault/virtue package with the virtues outweighing the detractors.

Reserve Winners Dog #27 S & M Saldivar & S Waterman & G Wright's. **GLENTOM'S SIMPLE CONQUEST.** By Ch Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley-Ch Glentom's Simply Red. Also from the American Bred class. Handsome youthful appearing tri male in excellent condition. Smoothly curved head. Head, substance, and bone not as striking as WD

Winners Bitch & BOW #10 Humberto Lara Romero's **ELVROC SHE DRIVES ME CRAZY.** By Nosrettap Celtic Star at Kilacabar-Elvroc Crazy Cleopatra. Black brindle and white bitch from the Open class. Beautiful head with very good fill, dark eyes with sparkling expression. Overall, quality make and shape. Very good condition. Moves well and holds her topline on the move.

Reserve Winners Bitch #14 Rebecca & William Poole's **ROCKY TOP'S KID ANTRIM** By Ch Rocky Top's Sundance Kid-Barrseas J'Aime La Vie. An attractive black brindle bitch with white markings who won the Bred By class. Nice rounded fill to the head with good depth of muzzle. Correct bite. Well made, esp in forequarters, but not quite as balanced as WB. Tended to break her topline in side gait, coming up in the rear. Still she moved with vigor and good drive,

BOV # 9 Lori & Greg Stafford, Rebecca & William Poole's **CH ROCKY TOPS OUTLAW KID** By CH Rocky Tops Sundance Kid ex Barrseas J'Aime La Vie. A powerful, youthful, but well filled-out red male with smut and white markings. Excellent head quality showing fill, depth and overall strength. Very attractive expression with a special sort of happy attitude shining through his small dark eyes. Slightly under. Well made, strong forechest and good angles front and rear. Moves well and purposefully. He has kind of commanding presence in the ring that is not fully developed. His handsome head and first rate make and shape make him truly eye catching. His BT spirit and demeanor in the ring makes him particularly attractive.

BOS # 18 Fred & Judy Schneider **CH LEBEOUF DUCHESS SOARING HAWK OF GLENTOM CG** By Ch Dazlin Defiance-Ch Glentom's PearlJam Demint RN. Red bitch with smut and white markings Very good length and depth of head and attractive profile. Lovely expression. Classy, very well made, she has a nicely arched neck that leads smoothly into a correct topline, which she holds when moving. Moves beautifully both directions.

Select Dog #25 Mike & Terri Cournoyer & Glenna Wright's **CH GLENTOM's DIRTY HARRY** By Marshelsea Hows About Harry ex CH Glentom I Have No Commint. It was a pleasure to see some really handsome males showing in BOV and this boy was one of them. A well balanced, compact red and white male. Quality head with correct bite and

well set ears. Nice dark eyes and expression. Good bone and substance. Shows with spirit. Jaunty movement.

Select Bitch #32 Robin Bishop & Glenna Wright's **CH GLENTOM COVERED IN RASBERRIES** . By Dutch Dreamer At Skyline BullPosition-Ch Avalon Glentom Cloud Cover. In BOV competition, I also had some good options in selections in bitches. In judging this level of quality, a comparison of overall virtue and breed type is critical to me. I chose this very attractive red and white bitch over several other strong competitors because of her lovely head quality (esp her profile, depth and fill of muzzle, and correct bite) and her strong shapely muscular body and condition. Typy with good bone and substance for size. Moved adequately.

Best Puppy: #30 Annie Cox's **CH ARNOLD'S JAVARKE QUEEN @SOME OKIES**. By Ch Javarke King at Arnold's-Malibu Salazar. A very classy, very correct youngster who moves well. Pretty head with dark, naughty, mischievous eyes and correct bite. Going through a growth spurt where she tends to stack/show high in rear. Feminine. She is not flashy, but she is sound and truly lovely!
