Winners Dog and Best of Winners

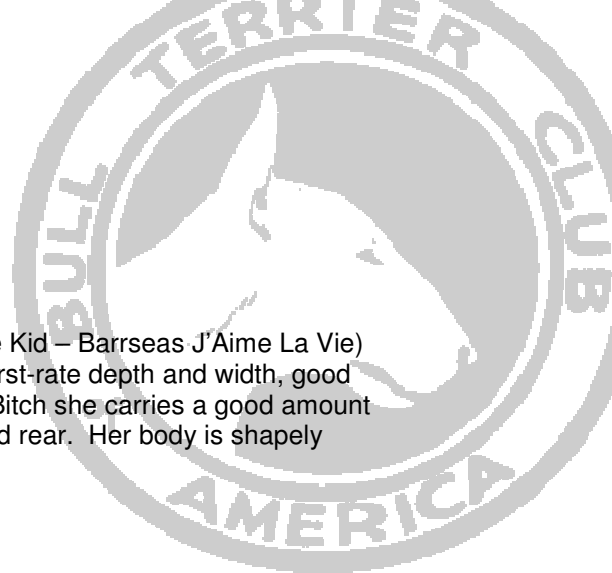
Martinez' **ARNOLD'S LEGEND OF STEAL AT MADE BULLS** (Ch. Javarke King At Arnolds – Bullsunlimited Gaboon Viper) A very handsome brindle and white puppy with a lovely head, sweeping profile and loads of width. Good expression though his ears could be set just a bit closer, bite is correct. Loads of dense bone though I would like to see him a few pounds lighter. He's nicely made with good quarters, a deep and broad chest and decent top-line. Moves well all ways of the ring.

Reserve Winners Dog

Lopez and Salazar's **ARNOLD'S THE LAST DRAGON AT A.G.R.** (Ch. Bullsunlimited Arashi – Evoly Olalde) Another brindle and white also with a very good head with a well turned and finished profile, good width and a correct bite. Not quite as well made as my Winners Dog he nonetheless is balanced in bone and substance though appears a bit soft and down in his pasterns. Shoulder and rear have good angles and he moves with ease all directions of the ring.

Winners Bitch

Wright and Cournoyer's **GLENTOM RULES WERE MINT TO BE BROKEN** (Ch. Glentom Conquistador Seeking Silver – Ch. Glentom I Have No Commint) An attractive, upstanding, rich brindle and white with a beautiful head, lovely profile and width, first-class expression and correct bite. Very feminine in outline, she has a beautifully arched neck, firm back and top-line, decent shoulder with a well bent stifle with good balance of bone and substance. She moves effortlessly down, back and in profile.



Reserve Winners Bitch

Poole's **ROCKY TOP'S KID ANTRIM** (Ch. Rocky Top's Sundance Kid – Barrseas J'Aime La Vie) Another lovely brindle and white again with a splendid head with first-rate depth and width, good expression and a correct bite. Lower stationed than my Winners Bitch she carries a good amount of strong, round bone, quality substance and good angles front and rear. Her body is shapely and she moves with ease around the ring.

Best of Variety

In a ring filled with a wealth of quality I choose Stafford and Poole 's **CH. ROCKY TOP'S OUTLAW KID** (Ch. Rocky Top's Sundance Kid – Barrseas J'Aime La Vie) This red-smut and white youngster has a powerful head with great depth and width, evil expression with a dark, small well-placed eye and ears right on top of his head. His bite is just slightly off from level. His masculine body is fit and well developed with gobs of bone all the way down to lovely, correct feet. His neck blends seamlessly to a firm top-line and with his powerfully angulated quarters he presents a masculine, balance silhouette. Not surprisingly, he moves purposely and typically all directions of the ring.

Best of Opposite Sex

Bishop and Wright's **CH. GLENTOM COVERED IN RASBERRIES** (Dutch Dreamer At Skyline Bullposition – Ch. Avalon Glentom Cloud Cover) This lovely red-smut and white in a tidy package has a beautiful head, an eye-catching profile with exemplary finish and width along with a piercing expression set off by her small, well placed eye and ears right on top of her head. Her bite is correct. She's an attractive balance of proportionate bone and substance with solidly muscled quarters that are well angulated. Her balanced, picturesque make and shape stand out whether standing or moving easily all ways of the ring.

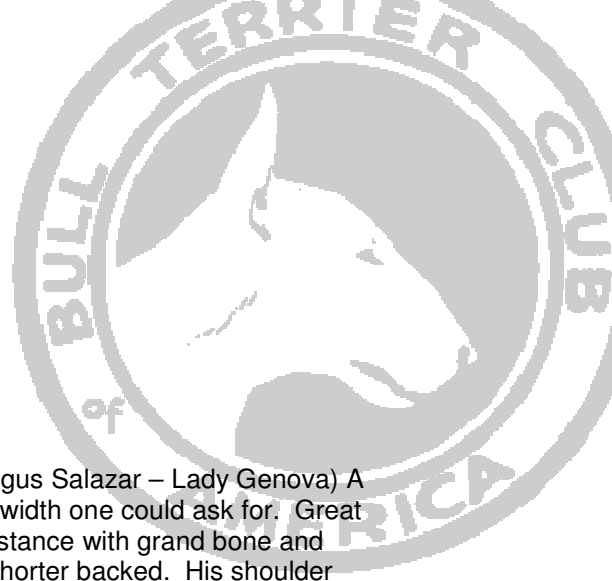

Winners Dog and Best of Winners

De Alba, Ortiz and De Jesus' **ROYAL LIONHEART DE ALBA** (Angus Salazar – Lady Genova) A strong, thuggish boy with a packed head with all the fill, finish and width one could ask for. Great expression with a tiny eye and a correct bite. He has loads of substance with grand bone and tremendous depth of body though ideally I would prefer him a bit shorter backed. His shoulder and rear are muscled and nicely angulated and he moves quite well down, back and in profile.

Reserve Winners Dog

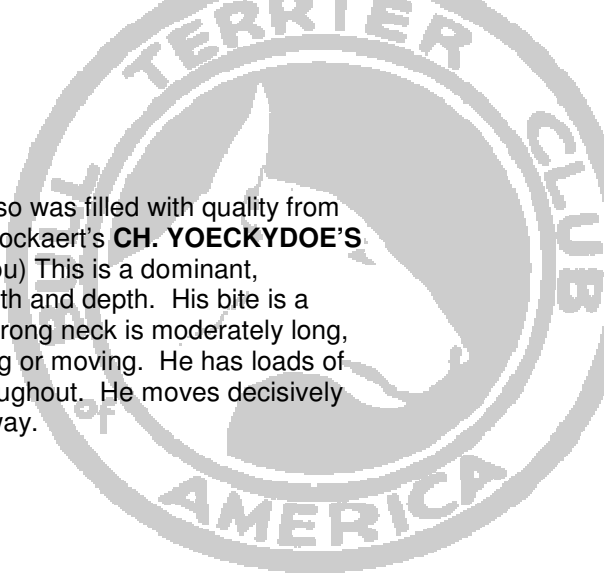
Hopkins' **TERJO'S IRISH BROKEN ARROW** (Emred Huntsman – Cwmdulais Shamrock of Terjo's) Another good-looking boy with a handsome head though just not quite as powerful as the Winners Dog. Expression, eye and ear set are all good. His bite also is correct. He's well balanced all over with enough bone and body, proportionate to his size. Shoulder and rear have good angles and he strides out easily all directions of the ring.

Winners Bitch

Wilson and Cooke's **LECHMERE'S CONSEQUENCES** (Ch. Super Bowl's Iggy Pop – Ch. Lechmere Glentom My Fair Lady) A very shapely youngster having a beautiful head with an arresting profile and a piercing expression. Her bite is just off from level. She has sweeping body lines with a long neck, strong top-line, a deep chest and well-developed, angulated quarters. Substance and bone are well balanced. Though not the most enthusiastic on the move, she's quite sound especially going away.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Saldivar's **ARNOLD'S PANDORA ROSE TO THE OCCASION** (Ch. Javarke King At Arnolds – Bullsunlimited Gaboon Viper) A very pretty puppy that I also liked very much, this girl has an attractive head with packed fill and finish, adequate width, great expression and a good bite. Though far from being mature, her body is shapely though I would prefer a bit more bone. Her shoulder has enough lay-back and her rear is strong and well bent. Though a bit puppyish on the move, she nonetheless covered the ring typically.



Best of Variety As in my Colored Best of Variety ring, this class also was filled with quality from start to finish. Standing out in this line-up to me was Jones and Knockaert's **CH. YOECKYDOE'S GAMIN** (Alecto Kool Barracuda of Kilacabar – Laureola's Up To You) This is a dominant, exceptionally masculine boy with an impressive head in profile, width and depth. His bite is a reverse scissors; expression, eye and ear set are first class. His strong neck is moderately long, his chest is deep and wide and his top-line is solid whether standing or moving. He has loads of solid, round bone, very robust quarters and is fit and muscular throughout. He moves decisively in profile and coming in, though I thought just a bit closely going away.

Best of Opposite Sex

Wright's **CH. GLENTOM STAR DREAMER** (Ch. Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley – Ch. Glentom Silver Lining) A very lovely bitch with a classic head combining a sweeping profile along with sufficient width, depth and a keen expression. Her bite is a reverse scissors. She's very balanced in silhouette with graceful body lines and first-rate bone. Her neck is long and arched and blends well to a firm top-line. She stands solidly on all fours with a good front end, a powerful rear and moves well as befitting her construction.
