Winners Dog and Best of Winners

Mullen's **IROC TWO FACE IN GLENTOM CITY** (Grabo Bugatti by Formula ex Glentom Creme Brulee) Compact brindle and white boy. Long filled head with a gently turned profile. Eyes and ears could be smaller but positioned correctly. Good bone and substance throughout. I would like more layback of shoulder and a longer neck. His movement has reach and drive. Rear was well muscled with good bend. Feet were maintained and tight.

Reserve Winners Dog

Ferandos' **HAWTHORN JESSE JAMES** (Emred Devil's Spy ex GCH Hawthorn Double Bock) Well marked black brindle and white dog. A mature dog with good bone and substance. Head was wide and strong. Eyes a bit kind, ears never stood. Decent movement from all directions.

Winners Bitch

Bankus, Wilsons' **NOTORIOUS NOTHING VENTURED NOTHING GAINED** (Notorious It's Nothing Personal ex Notorious Plenty O'Toole) Nicely marked brindle and white girl. Strong head with good bend and fill. Ears are large but held erect mostly and positioned ok. Eyes are small and positioned well. I would like more underjaw. Good fore-chest and angles on both ends. She toes out some on her front and I'd like a bit more bone and substance throughout.

Best of Variety

Anderson and O'Driscoll's **CH HAWTHORN KILLIAN'S IRISH RED** (Tawnbarr Devils Eye from Gorbain ex Hawthorn Shirley Temple) Super typey, compact red and white dog. He has a strong head with lots of fill. Great expression. Straight front, with good shoulders, good bone. Short backed. He moved parallel and with purpose in all directions. His compact yet strong frame is very useful in today's Bull Terriers.

Best of Opposite Sex

Cremeans, Leonard, Thomas' **GCH GRABO STRIKE A POSE AT IRUKANDJI** (Rabram Rock Star ex Grabo Bahama Moon) Striking brindle and white bitch. I've seen this girl a number of times and I have to say this is the best she has looked. Fully mature and of perfect weight. She has a long head with good fill and bend. Ears positioned perfectly even though they are slightly large. Front legs are straight but tends to toe out slightly at times. Front and rear angles are decent. Nice long neck. Drops off at the croup abruptly making the topline appear more roached. Covers ground well and her topline was solid on the move.

Select Dog

Kibler, Poole's **ROCKY TOP'S DREAM CHASER** (GCH Hawthorn Dragons Heart ex Rocky Top's Sweetest Dream) Compact brindle and white boy who loves to show. Great round bone and substance throughout. Tiny and tidy feet. I would like to see more reach of neck and a better layback of shoulder. Movement was good in all directions.

Select Bitch

Byzewski, Thomas' **CH GRABO PAINT THE TOWN RED AT MAGOR** (Rabram Rock Star ex Grabo Bahama Moon) Beautifully marked red and white bitch. Gently turned head of good length and fully packed. Small girl but lots of substance and bone for her size. I would prefer more leg under her to balance her out. Nicely muscled front and rear with good angles. Movement was good and she was handled to perfection.

Winners Bitch

Antle's **SIERRA VIEW CROSS INTO THE TREASURE VALLEY** (CH Grabo Bugatti By Formula ex Sierra View Bestuvall Cross he Golden Gate) Classy fully white bitch. She has a powerful head of good length and plenty of fill. Ears and eyes are positioned nicely and of correct shape. Nice straight front but lacking width in chest due to maturity. Still a bit butt high and topline was soft while stood for long. A quality bitch that needs only maturity.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Lamkins, Whitmans' **SOUTHRIDGE SPICY HOT INDULGENCE** (CH Clansmann Super Flye Guy ex CH Indulgence Flight of The Dragon) White bitch with ear marking. Well turned head with decent fill, not as fully packed as the winner and could use more underjaw. Eyes and ears could be smaller but are positioned well. Decent width of chest for her age. Good straight front not toeing in nor out. Angles are good on both ends. Good tailset that was carried horizontally.

Best of Variety

Thomas, Thomas' **GCH GRABO SUBTLE AS THUNDER** (Rabram Rock Star ex Grabo Bahama Moon) White carrying brindle boy. I've judged him a number of times now and he just keeps getting better! He is of moderate size but with maximum virtue. He has a very strong head fully packed with good underjaw and length. Tiniest of eyes and ears placed appropriately. Strong neck of good length, deep chest, round bone and immaculate feet. Short back into a well muscled and bent rear. The best part is he has the happiest demeanor and is a joy to watch.

Best of Opposite Sex

MacDonald, Prater-Pile's **CH FORMULA FOR A PRINCESSCA FOR STONEBULL** (Emred Devils Advocate ex GCH Actions Formula For A Drama Princess) Feminine white with red marking bitch. Well turned head of good length and ample fill. Tiny eyes and ears made for great expression. Front is straight with good round bone and tight feet. Good length of neck, nicely tucked elbows and depth of brisket. Strong topline with just a slight rise and a correct tailset. Rear is well muscled with good bend at the stifle.

Select Dog

Croucher, Thomas' **CH GRABO ACIE NOTHING ELSE MATTERS** (Rabram Rock Star ex Grabo Bahama Moon) Well-made white with brindle eye marking dog. He has good round bone but could use more strength throughout. Strong head that is slightly turned with adequate fill. Eyes could be smaller. Ears when used were positioned correctly and not oversized. He moved well in all directions.

Select Bitch

Mullens' **CH IROC RIDER OR VIE** (GCH Grabo Acie Holiday Moon ex GCH Glentom Crème Brulee) Strong white with brindle marked girl. She is well put together with great bone and substance. Good fore-chest into a straight front. Head is well turned and filled fully. Eyes could be smaller but are placed well. Ears when used were carried high. Movement was good with plenty of reach and drive.
