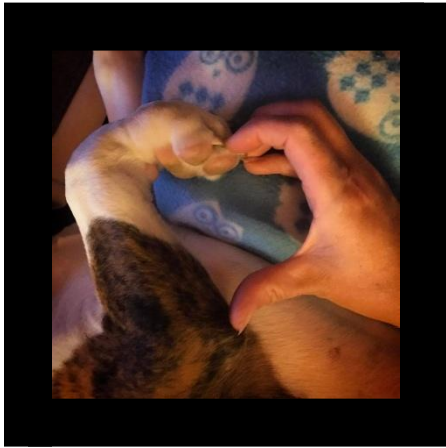


Seeking volunteers - become part of the heart of the weekend.
