DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Bull Terrier Club of America and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Bull Terrier Club of America reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Bull Terrier Club of America or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Each dog must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

REFUNDS

As per the AKC Fetch Judges Guide, when a Fetch test is cancelled, the club/organizer will contact any preregistered entrants. The club/organizer will communicate the change to any potential entrants by the method in which they originally advertised to those potential entrants. If the club/organizer cancels the Fetch test, preregistered entrants will be given a refund for their entry fees. The cancellation should be reported to fetchinfo@akc.org

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season can participate as the last dog(s) to compete. Bitches in season should not be waiting in the test area with other dogs, please keep them away from the test area until called at the end of the event.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

From the North: take I-65 South directly to Exit 131-B. Follow the signs for the Kentucky Exposition Center, turn left at the first traffic light onto Phillips Lane, and the Crowne Plaza Louisville Airport Expo **Center** will be the first hotel on the left.

From the South: take I-65 North and take Exit 131-B to merge onto I-264 W. Take Exit 11 following signs for the Kentucky Exposition Center / Fairgrounds Main Gate. At the first stoplight, turn left onto Phillips Lane. The hotel is the first property on the left.

From the East: take I-64 West toward Louisville. Keep right to merge onto I-264 West (Watterson Expressway) toward the Airport/Fair & Expo Center. Take Exit 11 for Phillips Ln / Fair & Expo Center. Turn left off the exit onto Phillips Lane. Continue straight for about 0.5 miles; your destination will be on the right.

From the West: take I-64 East toward Louisville. Keep right at the fork to merge onto I-264 East (towards the Watterson Expressway / Airport). Take Exit 11 for I-65 North toward Downtown Louisville. Keep right to merge onto I-65 North briefly, then immediately take Exit 131 for Phillips Lane. Turn right off the exit ramp onto Phillips Lane (eastbound). Continue for about 0.5 miles; your destination will be on the right.

From Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF): Head east on Terminal Dr. Use the middle lane to turn slightly left onto Terminal Dr/Circle of Flight. Continue to the traffic light and turn right onto Crittenden Dr. Follow Crittenden Dr for approximately 1 mile. Turn right onto Phillips Ln. The destination, 830 Phillips Ln, will be on your right.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
